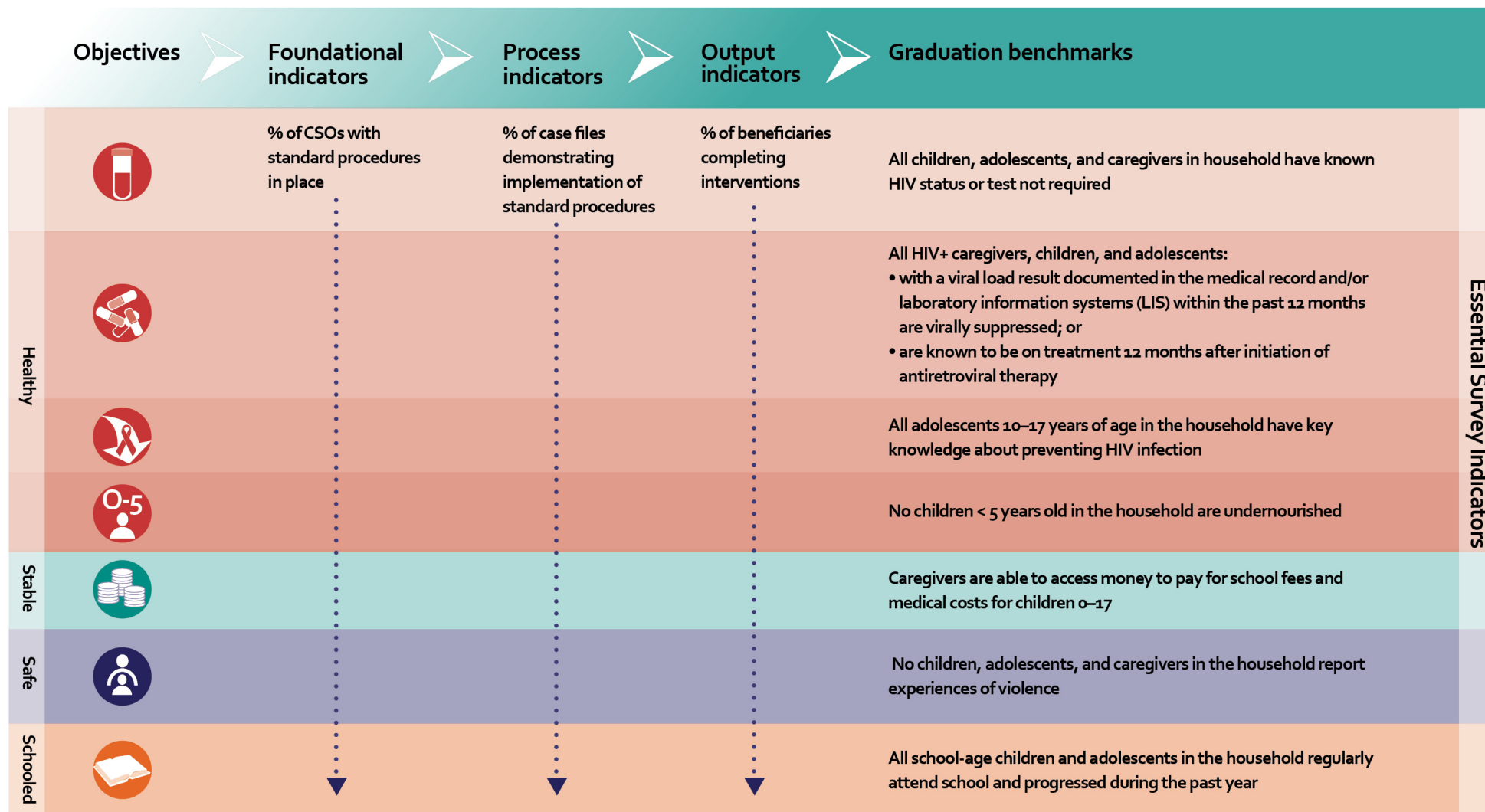


# OVC Indicator Matrix: Measuring the Pathway to Better Outcomes for Children Affected by HIV
