You are invited to join the HIV/AIDS Monitoring and Evaluation Network (AIMEnet) listserv. The listserv was established to create a global sharing/learning space for trained professionals working in monitoring and evaluation (M&E) of HIV/AIDS programs.

Listserv Objectives

The objectives of the listserv are to—

- ◆ Share member contributions of HIV/AIDS M&E information, including but not limited to best practices, publications, reporting systems, relevant questions, and technology
- ◆ Provide a space to hold forums on specific topics with guest moderators/professionals in the field
- ◆ Disseminate information on trainings, workshops, and other relevant announcements supplied by participants and the moderator
- ◆ Create a global network that supports dialogue among M&E professionals working in HIV/AIDS.

How to Join

To join, send an e-mail to moderator@AIMEnet.org and type “subscribe” in the subject line. In the body of the message, please include the following:

- ◆ Full name
- ◆ Country of residence
- ◆ Organization/institution of employment (or “consultant”)
- ◆ Preferred e-mail address.

Additional Information

The language of operation is English. The listserv is a “moderated listserv,” meaning that anyone who has joined may send an e-mail message (with topic for discussion, question, announcement, Web links, or other items related to the theme of the listserv) to moderator@AIMEnet.org. The message will be reviewed, and if appropriate for the listserv (suitable subject matter, relevance, and language), it will be “posted”—sent to all who subscribe. If an e-mail message is not accepted, the moderator will reply to the sender, stating why the message has not been posted. Participation is voluntary, and you can request to be removed from the listserv at any time.
