The need

- Extract the data from the District Health Information Software, version 2 (DHIS2) platform
- Analysis to make the data usable

The Bulletin

- Provides national updates monthly
- Reports on malaria performance indicators determined by the Ministry of Health and stakeholders
- Features analyzed tables with recommendations for decision making
- Reports on progress in regions and planned activities, such as supervision, training, and behavior change communication

The Audience

The Mali National Malaria Control Program, the U.S. President's Malaria Initiative, regional directors of health, and personnel in charge of local health information systems, including in regions and districts

What's needed next

- Regional bulletins to show subnational work
- Continued support to produce bulletins
- Quarterly bulletins as well as monthly
