EXERCISE 1

Exercise 1 involves identifying separate housing units and households. Please read the following canvassing situation descriptions and answer the questions following each situation.

Situation A: The Smith family owns a house. The Smith family rents two rooms in their house to a Mr. and Mrs. Jones. The Jones family's rooms are only accessible by walking through part of the Smith family's living area. The Jones family pays the Smith family to eat with them, in addition to paying rent.

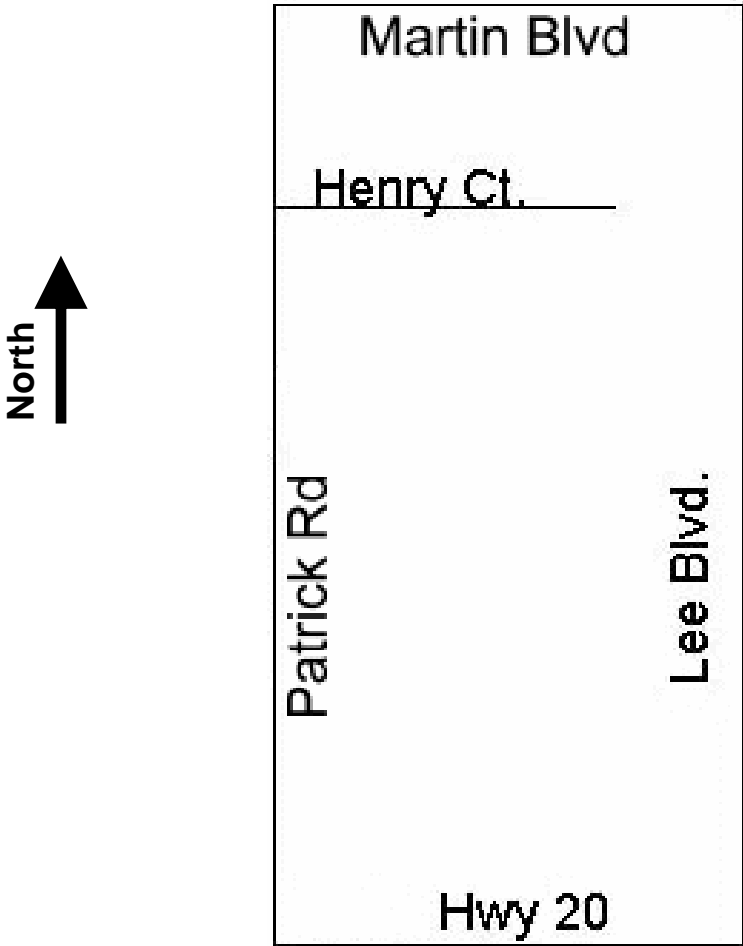
1. Does the Jones family occupy a separate housing unit?
2. Is the Jones family a separate household?
3. Does the Jones family get listed on a separate line in the address listing book?
4. Does the Jones family get interviewed on a separate questionnaire?

Situation B: The Smith family owns a house. The daughter of the Smith family lives in a small building that is located on the Smith family property with her husband. The small building is separated from the Smith family house. The daughter and her husband do not pay rent and share with the rest of the Smith family to provide food and other essentials.

1. Do the daughter and her husband occupy a separate housing unit?
2. Do the daughter and her husband get listed on a separate line in the address listing book?
3. Is the daughter and her husband a separate household?
4. Do the daughter and her husband get enumerated on a separate questionnaire?

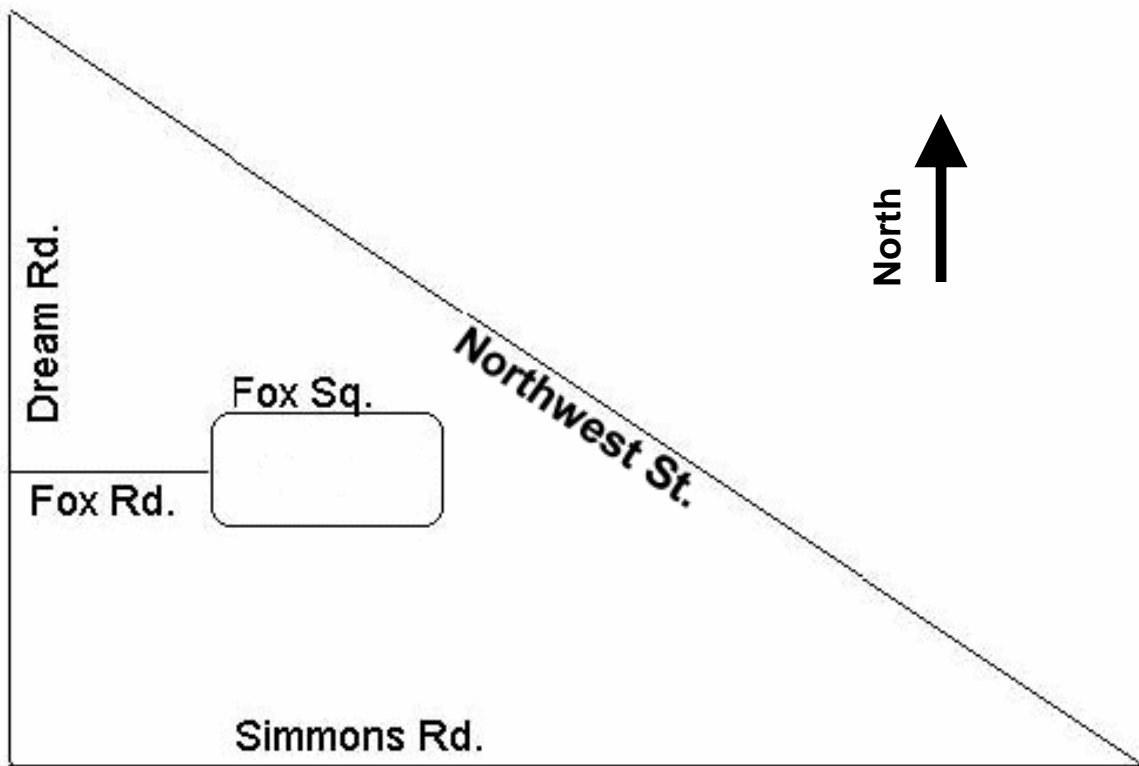
EXERCISE 2

In the following illustration, use the provided map scale below to determine the distance between the corner of Third and Main Streets and the Foot Path, or the distance between “X” and “Y”.

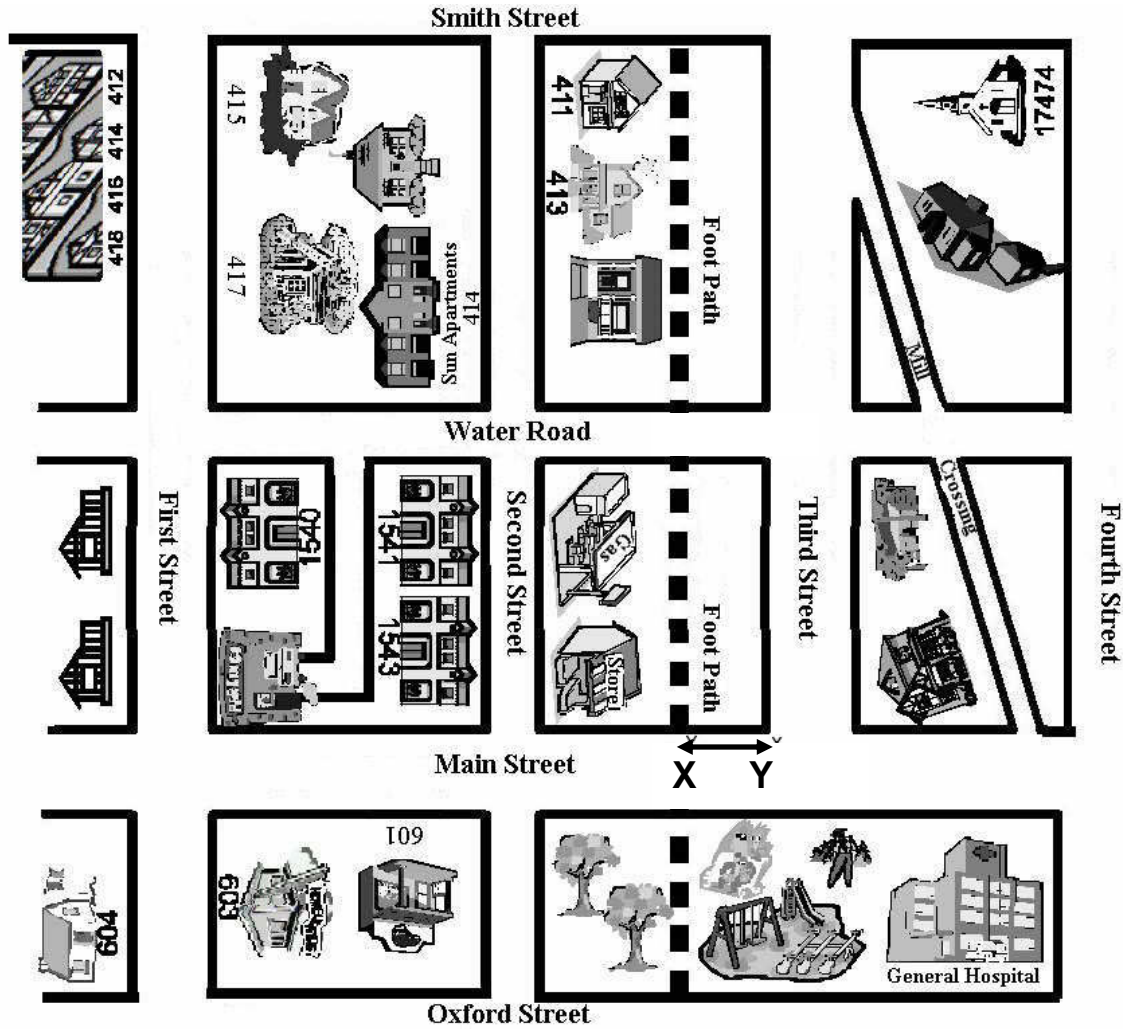
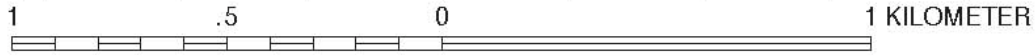
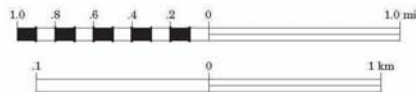
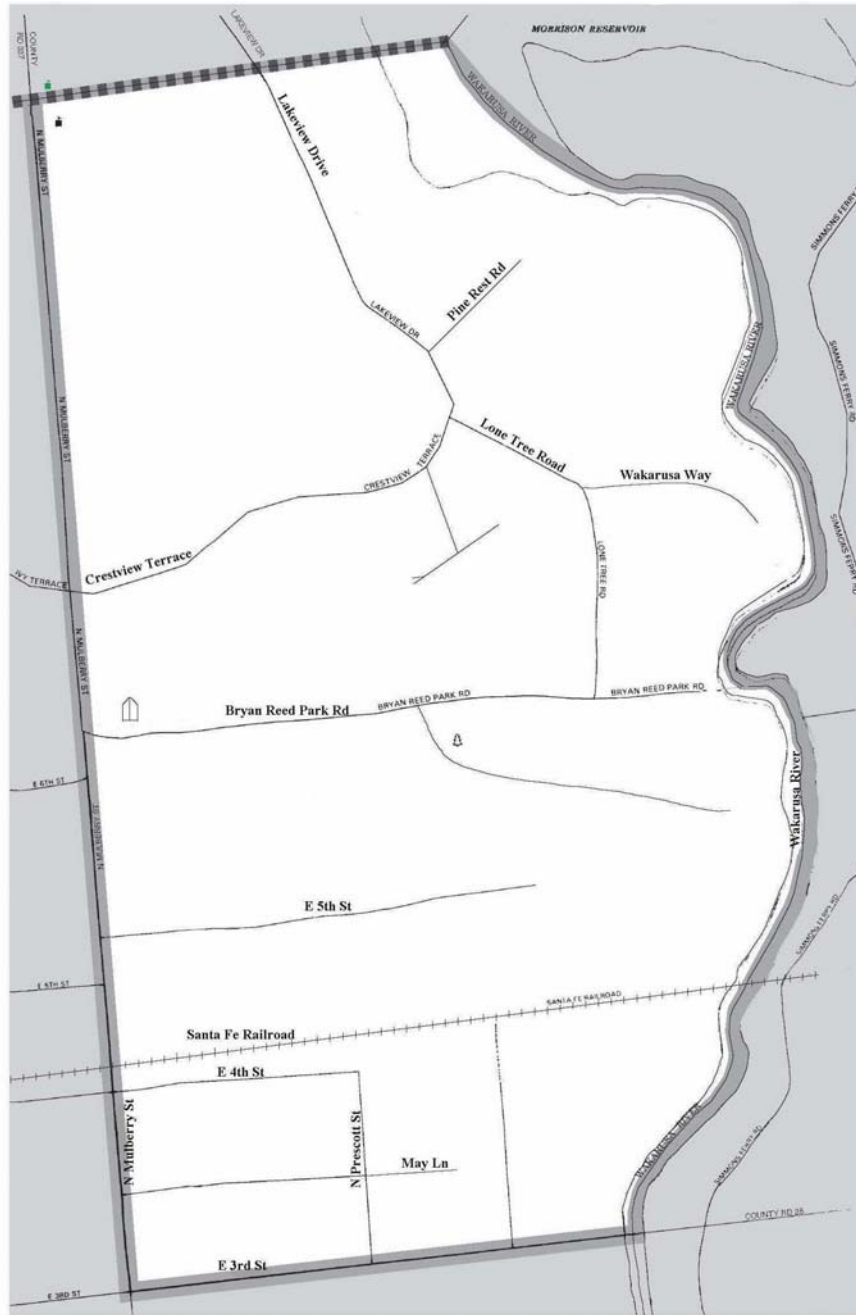


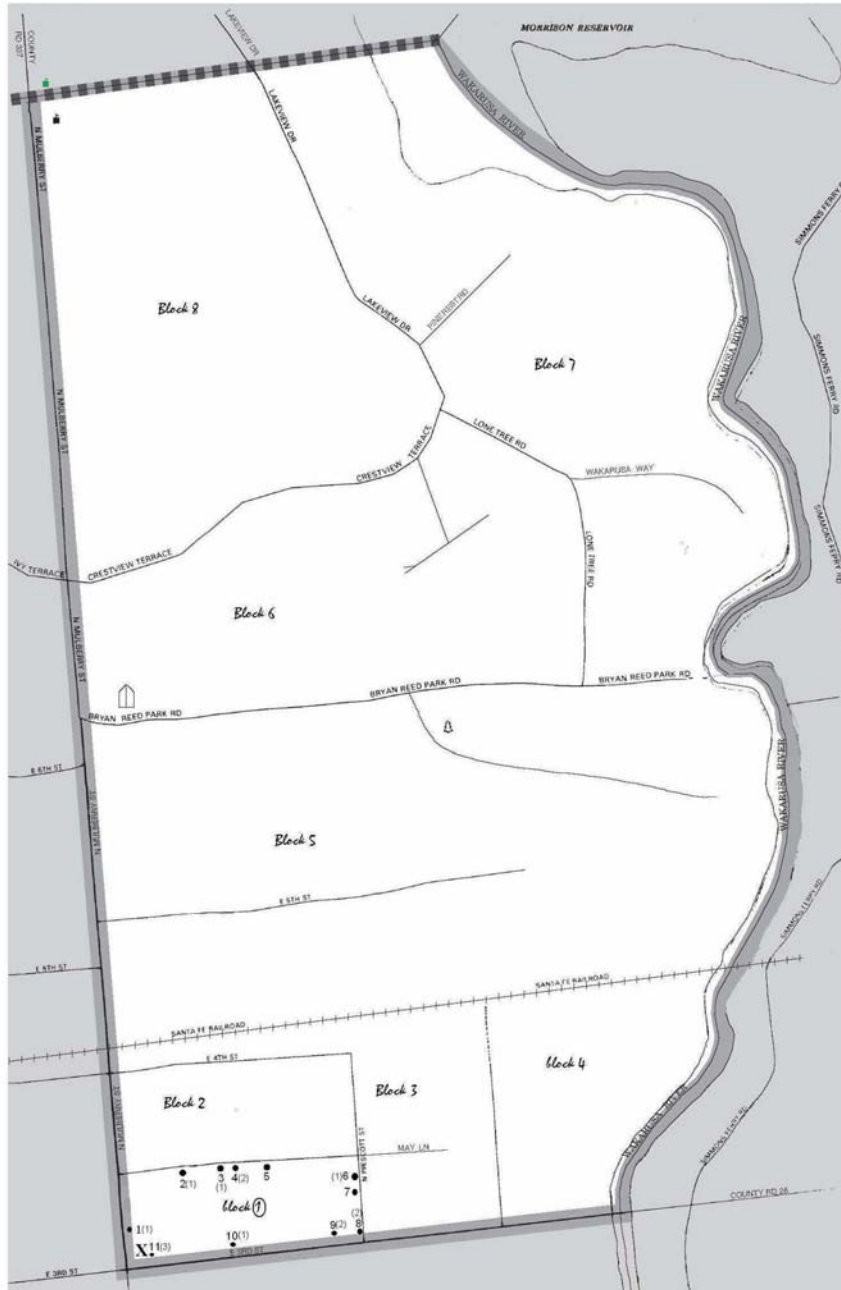
FIGURE 1. SAVVY CENSUS ASSIGNMENT AREA SAMPLE MAP

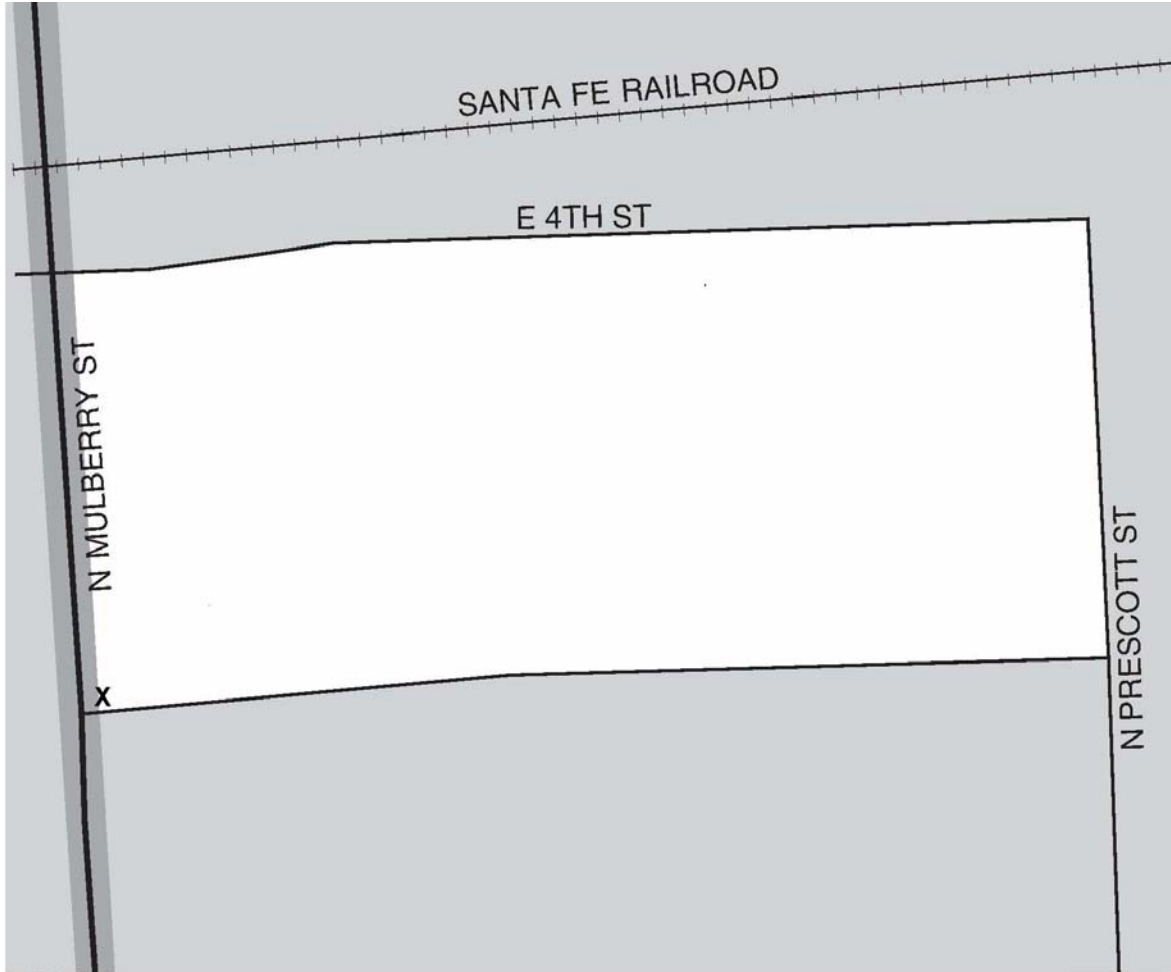
FIGURE 2. SAVVY CENSUS ASSIGNMENT AREA SAMPLE MAP — FIRST LOCK COMPLETED

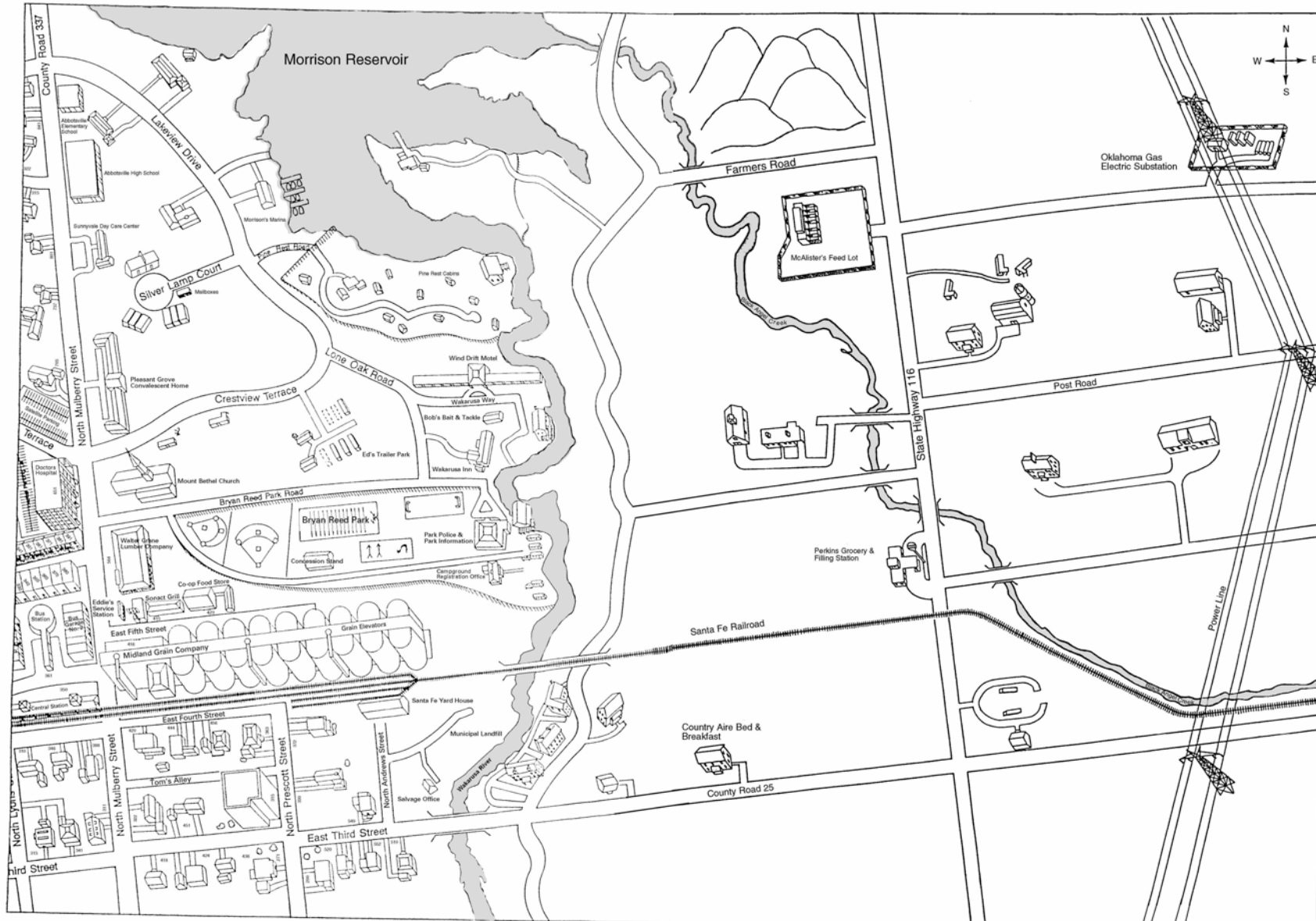
